

As some of you know, my parents live in the Midwest and in the last few years a few urgent medical concerns have come up for them. My family and I have decided to relocate to Wisconsin to spend more time with them and to be more available to help them with various needs. I will likely relocate in the summer of 2022.

The good news is that for many of you this does not need to be goodbye as I will continue to offer telehealth (phone and video) appointments with my new independent medical practice, which will be virtual. The focus of my new practice is helping women fix issues with their menses, hormones, skin, and gut health.

If you or your child have been seeing me for specific health concerns other than I have listed, you may also be able to continue your care with me virtually as well. You can certainly continue your care with one of the other doctors at Paracelsus too. You will not need to establish as a new patient again with my new practice. Please be advised, however, that I am no longer able to provide primary care, gynecological care, acute visits, or childhood wellness exams or any in person care since my new practice will be all virtual. You will need to have a Primary Care Doctor in addition to seeing me, which can be Paracelsus.
